The code for the padlocks and the key box on the clubhouse will be sent to you via email for security purposes. **The code is strictly for use by members only** and will change from time to time, we will notify you such changes by email so please keep your personal information updated. If you are the last to leave, PLEASE LOCK UP. Coloured tags have been introduced this year so that all fully paid up members can easily be identified these can be worn on your tennis shoes/trainers or on your kit bag, please do not be offended if a committee member asks you to show your tag as this is the only way we can make sure nonmembers are questioned.

A Wimbledon ballot is held at the club every year for the chance to buy tickets to the Wimbledon championship.

Adults and Juniors (9-17) will need to register for free with the LTA on [www.lta.org.uk](http://www.lta.org.uk) to get a BTM number, please ensure you select Milton Keynes Tennis Club as your place to play and opt in for the Wimbledon ballot. MKTC ticket allocation is based on the number of opted in BTM's so please sign up.

During social sessions members are expected to join in to play doubles. At other times, the courts are used for matches and coaching. There is at least one court available for use by members that can be booked via the Club Spark website or App, if there is no one waiting once you have finished your allocated time slot you may stay on until other members arrive. The maximum time slot allowance is 2 hours per court. A calendar of events can also be found on the MKTC website if you wish to see when courts are being used for special events or league matches.

Regular activities:

Junior team tennis in Aegon leagues and Milton Keynes league

Team tennis – MKTC has Men's Women's, and mixed teams competing in Bucks shield, Aegon and the Milton Keynes league

Other tournaments – Open mixed doubles, Veterans, singles, doubles, handicap, and Juniors.



There is a guest book in the clubhouse which you will need to sign your guests into and pay the appropriate amount. Adults £3 and Juniors £1 each.

Members may invite guests for a maximum of 2 visits per individual. Money is to be left in a named envelope and posted in the green mailbox on the wall in the clubhouse. There is a bar upstairs in the pavilion where members can buy food and drink, it is open daily on weekdays from 6pm and in the daytime during weekends, there are also changing facilities at the pavilion.
